

## INTERPRETATION

**Prose** – 5-8 minute performance of a selection from a short story, essay, or novel.

**Poetry** – 5-8 minute performance of a poem or collection of poems.

**Storytelling** – 5-8 minute performance of children's literature including fairytales and stories.

**Dramatic Interp** – 5-8 minute performance of a play script including 1-3 characters.

**Duo Interp** – 7-10 minute performance from a play script where two students act out a scene.

**Multiple Interp** – 10-15 minute performance of a play, novel, poetry, or short story with 3-8 people.

## **PUBLIC ADDRESS**

**Informative** – 5-8 minute prepared speech to inform the audience on a specific topic. Visual aids are commonly used.

**Sales** – 5-8 minute persuasive prepared speech to sell a product or service. Visual aids commonly used and encouraged.

**Oratory** – 8-10 minute prepared speech to motivate or convince the audience on an issue or problem.

Impromptu – 4-7 minute. Students are given an editorial and a maximum of 7 minutes to read it, prepare, and deliver a speech.

**Extemp** – 5-8 minute. Student is given a question in which they have 30 minutes and their own files to prepare a 5-8 minute speech answering the question.

**Broadcasting** – 5 minutes. Students are given newscopy and 30 minutes to prepare a 5-minute news broadcast that includes international, national, and state news with a 1-minute student written editorial.
